Jesse, Jr. University of Illinois, Urbana, Illinois In connection with the description of the new alloy bomb of nickel-copper-chromium¹ it may be of interest to report briefly the results of a series of experiments on the combustion of two standard substances, cane sugar and benzoic acid. These experiments were undertaken not only for the purpose of standardization but also to test the behavior of the instrument under actual working conditions. The principal features of difference between this bomb and other types are: (1) the substitution of an alloy, very resistant to the action of acids, for the usual platinum, gold, or enamel lining; (2) the use of a well protected rubber gasket for sealing the bomb instead of a gasket of lead; (3) the replacement of the ordinary...
